

## Science and Art Camps

These camps are designed to nurture students' innate curiosity by engaging them in challenging activities, eye-opening experiments, rewarding art projects, field trips (nominal fee), etc. We emphasize creative and analytical thinking, hands-on learning, cooperation, and team building.

Experienced camp staff are led by a **team of professional scientists and artists**, from a broad range of disciplines, to ensure that all camp content is of the highest caliber. Campers will be divided into **age-appropriate groups**. Mornings will focus on science, and afternoons on art.

### Session 1 (June 20-July 1)

#### **BLAST OFF: Flight, Rockets & Kinetic Art**

### Session 2 (July 5-15)

#### **MEDIEVAL TIMES**

Build a catapult and launch melons! Build other working levers and ancient tools, design and build three-dimensional gargoyles and castles. Take home your masterpieces and revel in the science and art of the Middle Ages.

### Session 3 (July 18-29)

#### **ECO-ADVENTURE**

Explore the great outdoors! Plant a garden, stream-walk, identify insects, photograph your environment, create and draw masterpieces using natural materials in surprising ways, and treasure so much more.

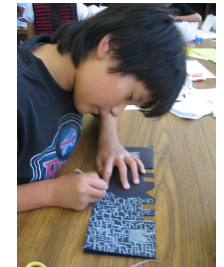
