Goodbye to a Dear Friend Larry Clements, Head of School, retires

In January 2018, Larry announced his retirement at the end of 2018-2019 school year.

For 11 years, Larry walked the halls of FCS as the head of the school. During his first months at FCS, Larry and the Board set a number of long-term goals: remedy the construction defects of our then-new building, recruit a larger and more diverse student population, stabilize the short- and long-term finances of FCS, achieve membership and accreditation in AIMS, attract and retain a more professional and diverse faculty, build a more sustainable administrative structure, develop a successful Middle School, and investigate the role of technology in our school. Those goals and much more were accomplished at Larry's helm with the support of the board and staff.

Over the next several years, the success and growth of the school showed as it retained and attracted students. A new problem was presented: lack of space. Unlike many independent schools, FCS grew consistently in the post-2008 recession years, achieving targeted and increased enrollment annually. At the beginning of the 2017/2018 school year, the school was fully enrolled - 248 children—engaged, talented, compassionate, and diverse by every measure.

The 2013 building addition brought increased space for science, Middle School, the visual and performing arts, and much-needed administrative offices, with no additional debt. Larry's leadership and thoughtful nature will be missed by all who knew him at FCS. We wish him peace and relaxation in his retirement.

Number of Students: 249 Students of Color: 51%


Students Receiving Financial Aid: 40%



Revenue Sources FY19


